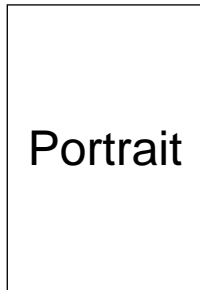


Edible Tasty Prints

Why is my image Landscape and not Portrait?
(Or vice versa)



Many times Edible Tasty Prints receives images without any comments from the person placing the order. In these cases, we have to 'assume' that the image is ready to print as it was provided to us; camera-ready. If there are no comments or instructions, how do we know whether and image should be printed portrait or landscape? We make this decision based on the dimensions of the image and some common sense judgment. For example:

This image arrived and is landscape.



We could print it the way it arrived, however, the purchaser most likely intended the Edible Tasty Print to be of the child and not the background. In this case, we would crop the image and print it portrait so that the child will be the focus of the Edible Tasty Print.
